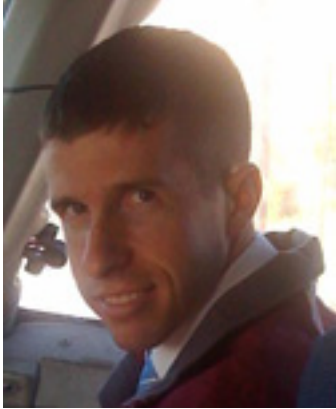


What I'm thankful for this Thanksgiving
