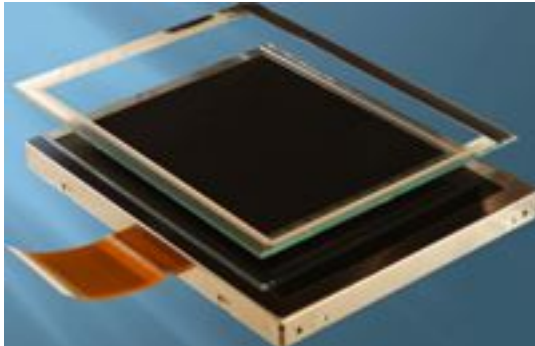


Touchscreen Uses Projected Capacitive Touch



Showing no film deformations over time, Ocular's Crystal Touch all-glass projected capacitive touchscreen works using a finger, styli, or a thin glove with the optical quality of a TFT or monochrome display. The scratch-resistant device exhibits auto calibration, a power input of 3 V, resolution of 3 million pixels max., operating temperature from -20°C to 75°C, storage temperature from -40°C to 85°C, and humidity from 10% to 90% at 40°C. The display offers a SPI or USB controller, Windows or Linux OS, and customizable TFT sizes with standard sizes including 4.3", 5.7", and 7". Pricing starts at \$22.
